The Seahawks lost a beloved member of their family in June, when **Mark Duncan** passed away from heart failure.

Mark served as the Seahawks assistant general manager from 1975 to 1982, and was the man most responsible for the design and construction of the first Kirkland practice facility.

Mark's death was the third to hit the franchise since December of 1992.

**Pete Gross**, play-by-play voice since the franchise's inception, died in December after battling cancer and **Elmer Nordstrom**, part of the original ownership group, passed away in April.
